DAHER wins two contracts for the design and production of integrated containers and shelters for EADS Defense and Security and THALES AIR SYSTEMS

Paris, May 21, 2010 – DAHER, European integrated equipment and services supplier has just signed two design and production contracts for integrated shelters and containers: the first as part of the DETECBIO V1 programme for EADS Defense & Security, and the second for production of a station to accommodate a new generation radar for THALES AIR SYSTEMS.

These two contracts underscore the equipment manufacturer's status as a key partner for industrial groups in the defence sector, which is a strategic sector for the group, supported by its innovative and customised "Manufacturing & Services" offering.

The design and production contract for the DETECBIO V1 programme shelters and containers includes the study and manufacture of a "shelters, MTM handling system and containers" batch for the SAMOA (Advanced Mobile Alert System). This order enables DAHER to position as EADS DS' partner for a programme contracted by the DGA. Each batch will comprise:

- Two 20-foot air transportable, mobile shelters equipped with attaching with runners and MTM,
- Several LRO type rotomoulded containers to stow the system's warning beacons.

The shelter developed and produced by DAHER for THALES AIR SYSTEMS is designed to accommodate a new-generation tactical radar.

The development and production of these integrated shelters and containers is underpinned by DAHER's comprehensive expertise in engineering, calculation & design, project management and integration, as well as long-proven skills in the fields of mechanics, electrics and hydraulics. For these contracts, the Group will be also leveraging expertise acquired in theatres of operations during missions in support of armed forces as well as prior experience working for industrial groups in the sector.
